An eye examination consists of two separate portions:

1. Medical evaluation (the detection and treatment of eye disease),
2. Refraction (determines whether someone who has never worn glasses or contacts needs them, or if their existing prescription needs to be changed).

If you feel that you might need your prescription updated, or believe you need glasses or contacts, then you should get the refraction part of your eye examination. Although the medical evaluation may be covered by your insurance, the refraction is usually a non-covered service.

The refraction fee is \$40.00, due at the time of service. In addition, you may have other fees for the examination, procedure, ancillary testing, copay, deductibles, coinsurance, and other non-covered or non-allowable services.

In electing to have a refraction you will also be covered for one (1) RX Check, free of charge within the first 60 days after your prescription was written.
